



### **MANDATORY SAFE SANCTUARY TRAINING**

**OCTOBER 25, 3:00 – 3:45 p.m.**

Beulah United Methodist Church's Safe Sanctuary-Child Abuse Policy demonstrates our total and unwavering commitment to the physical, emotional, and spiritual safety of all our children, youth, and vulnerable adults as well as the workers who serve them. Part of this policy is mandatory child protection safety training. All workers (paid and volunteer) with our children and youth are required to participate in this training, which will be conducted on October 25 at 3:00 p.m. in the Family Life Center. Workers in the following programs are required to participate: Sunday School, Children's Church, Nursery, Preschool, JAM, ROC, Aftershock, and Youth. Even if you have read the policy before, please attend this training as a refresher course. You will need a writing utensil, your driver's license number, and your social security number to complete the background check authorization if you have not done so already. If you are not currently working with these programs but would like to, please go ahead and attend this training session so you can be cleared to work when you are ready. Thank you for your service in these important ministries of our church.
